

In line with Early Education Funding (EEF) regulations, funded hours are provided free of charge. However, parents may choose to purchase optional chargeable extras to enhance their child's experience at nursery.

What Are Chargeable Extras?

Chargeable extras are optional services, activities, or items that fall outside the scope of the funded entitlement. Choosing not to pay for these will not affect access to funded hours.

Tax free childcare

We encourage all families to take advantage of the tax free childcare scheme and universal credit if eligible.

For TFC every £8 a family pays in, the government adds £2 (up to £2,000 per child each year — or £4,000 if the child has a disability).

Families can use their account to pay the nursery directly.

Funded hours are available without obligation to purchase extras.

Parents can provide their own meals, nappies, or resources if preferred in line with our packed lunch and opt out policy.
